Day One – SA 5/15 Depart USA

Depart the Quad Cities to connect to your overnight international flight to Rome.

Day Two – SU 5/16 Arrive in Rome

Our Representatives will meet you outside Baggage claim at the international airport in Rome. They will transfer your luggage to our coach and take you on an orientation tour of the city. Check into your hotel for dinner and overnight.



Day Three – MO 5/17 Ancient Rome

History is woven through the streets and neighborhoods of Rome as in no other city. Today you'll explore the many wonders of ancient Rome when you visit the magnificent Colosseum, Mamertine Prison and the Pantheon. From the most sacred hill of ancient Rome, Campidoglio, you'll view the Forum. You'll also view the Circus Maximus, the Arch of Titus, the famous Baths of Caracalla and the Arch of Constantine. You'll see the Victor Emanuel Monument and the Monti Region, Rome's most ancient neighborhood that spreads over three of her seven hills. In the afternoon, we will explore the Basilica di San Clemente, where layers of history lay in the excavations beneath the present church.

Day Four – TU 5/18 Vatican Rome

Christianity came late in her long history,

conquering and changing Rome in a way few other invaders have. Today, you will experience the glory of Christian Rome when you visit the Vatican, home to one of the greatest museums in the world. And, of course, you'll enter St. Peter's Basilica and the Sistine Chapel, where you'll view Michelangelo's frescoes which have been restored to their full, colorful glory. The rest of the day is free to take in some of Rome's most beautiful sights on your own. Stroll or bike through Villa Borghese Park and decline the Spanish steps on to the Piazza de Popolo and visit its churches and many shops. Visit the oldest church in Rome, the Pantheon and toss a coin in the Romantic Fontana di Trevi. Stroll through the Piazza Navona and see its beautiful fountains and open air market. Consider taking a night walking tour of Rome (optional).



Day Five – WE 5/19 Catacombs and Assisi.

Walk through the Catacombs where Christians worshipped and buried their loved ones during Roman persecution. Then leave Rome behind and head for Assisi, the home of Saint Francis. For the next three days, we slow down to take in the Italian culture in one of the most beautiful ancient cities in Italy and one of the most spiritual cities in the world. In the mornings, we will travel just outside Assisi to the farm of Bruce and Ruth Davis, our retreat leaders for our time in Assisi.

Surrounded by vineyards and a beautiful red poppy covered field, we will enjoy times of prayer and are guided by Bruce in the spirituality of St. Francis. In the afternoons we take time to walk to some of the significant sights in the life of St. Francis. All our meals in Assisi are a sampling of country Italian cooking and lunches in Assisi is included in the price.

This morning, celebrate Mass in one of the local churches. This afternoon, we will journey to the top of the mountain to look back over the valley where Assisi stands.

Day Nine – SU 5/23 To Tuscany

This morning, travel to one of the most charming and picturesque of all the Tuscan hill towns, San Gimignano. Magical medieval towers dominate the town. At one time there were more than 70 towers, but only 14 remain today. Continue on and explore Greve in Chianti, our base for the next three nights.

Day Ten – MO 5/24 Florence

Less than 20 miles north is Florence, nestled between a line of hills and the banks of the Arno River. You will have time to enjoy the beautiful gardens and stroll through the open-air markets. Every street, every square and winding alley of Florence is a showcase for Romanesque, Gothic and Renaissance grandeur. Among the wealth of masterpieces to be found in Florence, you'll see the Piazza della Signoria with its Neptune Fountain and Vecchio Palace, the Santa Maria del Fiore Cathedral which houses Michelangelo's unfinished Pietá, the Baptistery which features Ghiberti's famous Gates of Paradise and the Academy where you can view some of Michelangelo's finished and unfinished work, including the awe-inspiring David.

Enjoy a day of Leisure, perhaps exploring around Greve, or return to Florence for another day of exploring on your own. No Guide or Bus Service on Day 11
